





INTRODUCTION

The DEP Foundation is the entry-level stage of the Digital Entrrepreneurship Program designed for 100-level learners. At this stage, participants are introduced to essential mindsets, digital skills, and personal development practices that prepare them for deeper exploration in DEP 201 and DEP 202. The program is delivered in a hybrid model—a mix of physical and online learning—to ensure inclusivity, flexibility, and practical experience.

PROGRAM OBJECTIVE

- Introduce learners to the core principles of growth mindset, self-discovery, and adaptability.
- Build foundational digital literacy skills needed for academic and career success.
- Develop essential soft skills such as communication, teamwork, and time management.
- Provide exposure to career pathways in entrepreneurship, intrapreneurship, and techpreneurship.
- Prepare learners for continuity into DEP 201, where they will begin deeper problem-solving and specialization.



PROGRAM METHODOLOGY

- Delivery Mode: Hybrid (physical touchpoints + online learning).
- Learning Tools: Google Meet (live sessions), LMS (assignments & resources), Google Workspace (Docs, Slides, Sheets), Canva (creative exercises).
- Facilitation Approach: Interactive live sessions, guided reflections, peer learning, guest talks, and practical digital assignments.
- Physical Engagement: Orientation, peer collaboration, and showcase events.
- Mentorship Support: Tutors and facilitators guide learners through weekly themes with personalized feedback.
- Progress Tracking: Weekly reflections, mini-assignments, and a showcase at the end of the program.

OUTCOMES

By the end of DEP Foundation, learners will:

- Understand the principles of a growth mindset and self-leadership.
- Demonstrate basic proficiency in digital tools for productivity and communication.
- Apply foundational skills in teamwork, communication, and time management.
- Show awareness of community problems and how they connect to career opportunities.
- Gain exposure to entrepreneurship, intrapreneurship, and techpreneurship pathways.
- Build confidence through public speaking and peer collaboration.
- Earn a DEP Foundation Certificate and transition into DEP 201 with readiness for advanced learning.
